Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 11 residents and 4 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We currently have 2 residents in quarantine in our COVID unit and 0 positive staff members at this time.

As mentioned in our previous communications, we continue to COVID test staff twice weekly and residents once per week.

Today, the residents and staff are making history while helping our facility and community to be a safer place by receiving their first dose of the COVID vaccine.

Our second COVID vaccination clinic is scheduled for February 3, 2020. It is necessary to receive the second vaccination to achieve the full benefit.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

WEEKLY UPDATE

January 20, 2021

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 11 residents and 4 staff members test positive for COVID-19. All previously positive residents currently residing with us have recovered and all staff members that previously tested positive have recovered and are back to work. We continue to test our staff twice per week and our residents once a week.

Through our partnership with Walgreens, we successfully completed our initial round of COVID-19 vaccinations for residents and staff on January 13, 2021. As previously noted we received the Pfizer vaccine.

We are scheduled to conduct our second vaccination clinic, again partnering with Walgreens, on February 3rd, 2021. It will also be the Pfizer vaccine. We are required to obtain your consent for the second vaccination even though you have previously given consent for the initial dose.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility. As mentioned in previous correspondence we have had a total of 11 positive COVID-19 cases with our residents and 4 positive COVID-19 cases with our staff members, plus 1 additional positive case in a consultant.

Even though we have no current cases of COVID-19 in the facility, we continue to test our staff twice per week and our residents one time per week. We continue to follow established safety and infection control protocols.

We are scheduled and ready for our second COVID-19 vaccination shots scheduled for February 3rd for both staff and residents. Walgreens will once again distribute the Pfizer vaccine.

To recognize our employees for their continued commitment and efforts to keep our residents and one another safe by wearing appropriate PPE and regular handwashing, not only in the facility but also when they are out in the community, we are excited to announce a new HERO recognition program. Monthly nominations may be made by coworkers, residents, and even family members. I am inviting you to participate if you have experienced a positive interaction with a staff member caring for your loved one or perhaps your loved one mentioned to you something meaningful a staff member did for them. Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. Since the onset of this virus, we have had 9 residents and 4 staff members test positive for COVID-19. We currently have 2 residents with COVID19 in our COVID unit and 1 staff member with COVID19 quarantining at home. We continue to test our staff 2 times per week and our residents once a week.

Walgreens will be at the facility on January 13, 2021 to conduct our COVID19 vaccination clinic. Residents that opted for the vaccine will receive their 1st dose that day. The second vaccination clinic is scheduled for February 3, 2021. Residents will receive their 2nd dose of the vaccine on that day.

As always, we are working hard to keep everyone in our community safe and we will continue to practice the enhanced safety precautions that are known to prevent the spread of COVID-19, such as only essential personnel are allowed inside the facility and we screen them for signs and symptoms of illness prior to entering. Our residents are continually monitored and staff is using PPE as recommended by the CDC. Staff is frequently reminded and encouraged to practice social distancing and to use hand sanitizer and frequently wash their hands when they are in the facility and out in the community. We ask them not to report to work if they have symptoms of illness.
