

COVID STATUS UPDATE November 24, 2021

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as notification regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. As of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility with residents or staff members.

I am happy to announce updated visitation practices, based on the most recent Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) guidelines.

We will allow indoor visitation at all times for all residents regardless of their vaccination status. You will no longer need to call ahead and schedule visits. We will request that you continue to adhere to the core principals of infection control to include hand hygiene, social distancing and wearing a face covering. Additionally, the COVID-19 screening process upon entry will continue to be in place. It is important to limit your movement throughout the facility. Please go directly to the resident room or visiting area as applicable. If the resident you are visiting has a roommate, please conduct your visit elsewhere in the facility if possible.

Residents on transmission-based precautions or quarantine, will be allowed visitors in their room with both the resident and visitor wearing a well fitted face mask.

We will not allow visitation on an active COVID unit unless for compassionate care visits, in which case the facility will ensure appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is worn.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
