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**WEEKLY UPDATE**

**February 25, 2021**

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility. As mentioned in previous correspondence we have had a total of 11 positive COVID-19 cases with our residents and 4 positive COVID-19 cases with our staff members, plus 1 additional positive case in a consultant.

Although we have no current cases of COVID-19 in the facility, we have continued to test our staff twice per week and our residents one time per week. We will continue to follow established safety and infection control protocols.

Our third COVID-19 vaccination clinic is being conducted today, February 24<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

We will begin supervised indoor visitations on Monday, March 1, 2021. The following protocols will apply:

- Limit of 2 guests per visit (children are included in this count).
- All visitors will be screened for symptoms of COVID-19 at each visit. Please provide a copy of your COVID-19 vaccination, if applicable. We will request that you complete a Point of Care Rapid Test, as supplies permit.
- All visitors will be required to wear a face mask - \*note this also applies to children 5 years of age and older. You can either bring your own mask or one will be provided to you upon entry.
- All visitors will perform hand hygiene before and after each visit.
- Social distancing must still occur during the visit (no physical contact allowed).
- Visits will be held in a designated area.
- Visits will start at the top of the hour and last no more than 30 minutes. Please arrive 20 minutes prior to your visit to allow time for collection and processing of your rapid test.
- Residents occupying the quarantine unit will not be allowed visitors until which time their quarantine is complete.

With the reimplementation of facility visits we request that you limit your visitations to 1 visit per resident per week. This will assist in reducing the risk of exposure to our population and allow for the most opportunities for visitations.

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We are also very happy to announce that you can resume bringing in food for your loved one when you visit, with a couple of caveats. Since the visits are socially distanced without contact, you would need to label the food, place it in a bag and give it to the receptionist upon entry to the center. Food consumption is not permitted in the visitation area. To further clarify, you may only provide food for your loved one. Example – it cannot be a pizza to be shared with others residents. You may also want to consider placing a food order for delivery directly to our center. These orders/deliveries would need to be paid for at the time you place the order prior to delivery.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
