The new guidelines regarding indoor visitation state:

Facilities should allow indoor visitation at all times and for all residents (regardless of vaccination status) except for a few circumstances when visitation should be limited due to high risk of COVID-19 transmission to include residents with active COVID-19 and residents in quarantine.”

The facility must still schedule visits for specified lengths of time and limit visitor movement in the facility, rather than visiting directly to a resident’s room, when shared, they could go to a designated visitation area.

Visitor COVID-19 testing is not required. However, we must still follow the core principles of infection control in part to include screening of all visitors for signs and symptoms, to include a temperature check, inquiring about the visitor’s vaccine status, hand hygiene, face coverings, and social distancing.

If the resident is vaccinated (refers to a person who is greater than 2 weeks following receipt of the second dose in a series or greater than 2 weeks following receipt of one dose vaccine per CDC guidelines) they may choose to have close contact including touch with their visitor, while wearing a well fitted mask and performing hand hygiene before and after the visit.

March 4, 2021

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that, as of today, we have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility. As mentioned in previous correspondence we have had a total of 11 positive COVID-19 cases with our residents and 4 positive COVID-19 cases with our staff members, plus 1 additional positive case in a consultant.

We are very pleased that we were able to reimplement in-person visits this week. As a reminder the following practices apply:

- Limit of 2 guests per visit (children are included in this count).
- All visitors will be screened for symptoms of COVID-19 at each visit. Please provide a copy of your COVID-19 vaccination if applicable. We will request that you complete a Point of Care Rapid Test, as supplies permit.
- All visitors will be required to wear a face mask *note this also applies to children 5 years of age and older. You can either bring your own mask or one will be provided to you upon entry.
- All visitors will perform Hand Hygiene before and after each visit.
- Social distancing must still occur during the visit (no physical contact allowed).
- Visits will be held in a designated area with staff oversight.
- Visits will start at the top of the hour and last no more than 30 minutes. Please arrive 20 minutes prior to your visit to allow time for collection and processing of your rapid test.
- Residents occupying the quarantine unit will not be allowed visitors until which time their quarantine is complete.

With the reimplement of facility visits we request that you limit your visitations to 1 visit per resident per week. This will assist in reducing the risk of exposure to our population and allow for the most opportunities for visitations. Please call the receptionist to schedule your visit at 301-334-2319.
