We are initiating group meals and activities once again in the dining rooms. Residents will be interviewed to determine their dining and activity preferences, be it in their rooms or the dining room setting. Social distancing of 6 foot must still be maintained. Residents will be assisted to perform hand hygiene before and after meals and activities. They will also need to wear a mask to and from the dining room. Masks may only be removed while consuming food and beverages.

Pets are now welcome to visit their loved one. However, we must have a copy of current vaccination records on file and the pets must be on a leash and must not be experiencing any sickness at the time of the visit. Residents will be asked to perform hand hygiene after touching the pet.

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that we currently have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility.

Recently the CDC has announced updated mask guidance for the general public. Please take note, that at this time our mask policy has not changed. For the protection of our residents, all visitors and residents are required to wear a mask throughout the visit. As a reminder, if you are visiting someone who rooms alone, you are permitted to visit in the room if desired. If you are visiting with someone in a shared room then you would need to visit with them in the designated visitation area or outdoors if that is preferred. If the resident you are visiting is fully vaccinated they may choose to have close contact with you including touch. Otherwise we would ask that you social distance during your visit.

**May 26, 2021**

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our weekly update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. We are happy to report that we currently have no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our facility.

Following are a few topics for this week:

- Our vending machines will soon be fully stocked and available for resident use.
- We are resuming facility tours for family members that may need to potentially place a loved one.
- Families may now resume doing resident laundry if they so choose, please just let us know.
- For vaccinated residents and visitors: when visits are in a resident’s private room (no roommate) or designated visitation area, residents and their visitors may choose to have close contact (including touch) and to NOT need to wear source control (mask). However, the visitor(s) must still pass a screen upon entry and wear a mask to and from the designated area of visitation. The visitor should socially distance from healthcare personnel and other residents and visitors.
- When either the resident or the visitor is not fully vaccinated the safest approach for everyone is an outdoor visit, social distancing and source control (mask). However, if the resident is fully vaccinated and they choose to have close contact (including touch) with their visitor(s), both must wear well-fitting source control (masks). The visitor would still need to pass a screen upon arrival for the visit.

*Visits start at the top of the hour and last 30 minutes. No more than 2 visitors at each visit. Please schedule with our receptionist at 301-334-2319.*
