COVID STATUS UPDATE
August 25, 2021

Dear Residents and Families/Representatives,

Please accept this letter as our status update regarding the status of COVID-19 in our facility. As of this update we have 1 staff member, and 1 contract worker that have tested positive for COVID-19. Currently there have been no residents test positive for COVID-19.

These COVID positive events place the facility in what is considered an outbreak status.

During the outbreak phase residents and staff members are tested at least weekly until there are no more positive cases detected and then at least another 14 days beyond that as a matter of safety.

Visitation has been limited to outdoors (weather permitting) or moved to a window visit throughout this phase. Additionally, residents and guests should wear masks, refrain from touching and social distance. Residents may also choose to select virtual or telephone visits. As a reminder the visitation schedule is listed below.

Monday – Friday Visitation	10AM – Noon Resident Lunches Noon to 1 1 PM -4 PM	2 visitations available No visitation during lunch 3 visitations available
Saturday and Sunday Visitation	9 AM – Noon	3 visitations available

Visits start at the top of the hour and may last for 30 minutes. During this outbreak phase, visits will be monitored.

Communal meals, and activities have been placed on hold during this period of time also. Meals and activities will be provided in rooms. Resident will also receive therapy serves, as prescribed, in their rooms. We encourage all residents to stay in their rooms. However, should they need venture into a common area we will request their wear a mask or face shield.

Thank you for your support as we navigate this pandemic and do our best to keep you loved ones safe and happy.

Please continue to check our website for weekly updates as well as notification of new cases. As always, we will notify you if we receive confirmation of a new positive case in our facility and we will reach out to you individually if your loved one is displaying symptoms of COVID-19 or tests positive for COVID-19.
